New Mailboxes

Tot Lot Playground

After the Board received a recent comprehensive inspection of the cluster's 15yr+ playground system, the Board took action and had the playground replaced. A follow-up inspection on 28 Oct ensured the new equipment meets safety standards.

Entrance Sign

The Reston Association Design and Review Board approved three entrance sign options, which were sent to homeowners for their vote. An overwhelming amount of feedback resulted in a reassessment of cost, landscaping, and an addition of a fourth design. Drainage

The Board selected the winning bid among three companies and met with the contractor to re-assess the cluster's drainage problems. The Board then prioritized the high-impact areas and developed a multiyear plan. Phase I will start on 13 Nov. Please see the Glencourse Cluster website for details.



Tree Removal

DuPont recently approved removal of dead/dying trees affected by the Imprelis herbicide. Removal of these trees is scheduled for 15 Nov. The board also approved removal/pruning of trees not affected by Imprelis but are dead and/or pose a substantial liability to residents. Tree removal/pruning is scheduled for the week of 24 Nov.
