The past year was a period of measured activity by the board and supporting residents.

- The basketball court was re-leveled and paved.
- The drainage project was expedited to address the common areas behind upper Winged Foot firelane.
- Successfully dealt with a near-record snowfall (in a single day) and snow removal efforts.
- A landscape committee was formed which drove the development of an RFP, the competitive bidding, review and selection of a landscaper and design for the front entrance, corner of Winged Foot and Glencourse as well as the lower Glencourse common area.

All in all, this year promises to be even more active with landscaping, neighborhood watch committee and other special projects. As we continue to work on additional efforts to improve our community, we look forward to everyone's support and further involvement!



Entrance Sign & Landscaping!

On 11 April, the Reston Design and Review Board approved the cluster's proposal for an entrance sign and landscape enhancements for the front entrance and lower Glencourse lawn. Installation of the front entrance sign began on 2 May with landscaping to follow. Please do not disturb the new plantings. It will take one-three years for the plants to fully establish. In the meantime, feel free to enjoy the beautiful landscaping!

Lighting

Management is working to replace 12 existing lamps with brighter LED lamps and waiting on a second quote to add an additional 12 lamp posts.

Drainage

The BoD is looking into implementing a combination of French drains and rain gardens to improve drainage behind units 2136-2194 Glencourse Ln. The contractor is awaiting proper permissions from Fairfax County to drain into the adjacent estuary. We thank you for your patience!
