The board submitted design options to the Reston Association Design Review Board (DRB) for our front entrance sign. Drainage

The board received multiple bids from drainage companies assessing the drainage issues affecting the cluster. The Board is reviewing the bids, meeting with the contractors, prioritizing high impact areas, and developing a multiyear plan to address all of areas in need of an upgrade. We will work with residents as we implement a phased drainage plan.

Landscaping/Tree Replacement

The Board had an arborist come out and survey all cluster trees damaged by the Imprelis herbicide. Based on the arborists risk assessment, several trees impacted by the Imprelis herbicide need to be pruned or removed because they are dead and pose a substantial liability. Work will be scheduled early fall. In addition, the Board is working with an arborist and RA to develop a combined Master Tree Replanting Plan and a Master Landscaping Plan.

Tot Lot Playground

The Board hired an independent certified inspector to assess our tot lot playground. Once the Board receives the inspection report it will work quickly to address any safety concerns.

REMINDERS!
