Drainage

Work for Phase II (2136-2194 Glencourse Ln) of the multi-year drainage plan is pending. We are waiting on results from land surveys and permission from FFX County to drain into the estuary. Additional options will be provided as we gain a better understanding of the drainage issues affecting these areas. The drainage contractor will also meet with residents to begin assessment of Phase III (2000-2008 Wingfoot Ct).

Cluster Standards

TWC Management will conduct a semiannual inspection of residential units to identify areas not compliant with cluster standards. Cans: Aluminum/bi-metal/tin

Glass: bottles, jars (NO window glass)
