Entrance Sign

It is finally time to vote for the sign of your choice! Based on feedback from last year's voting event, the board reevaluated the costs and added a fourth more cost-effective option. Tree Removal

Priority 1 dead/dying trees affected by the Imprelis herbicide and those that pose safety hazards to residents were removed in December 2014. The remaining Priority 2 trees that are in decline will be serviced 11-19 Feb, weather permitting. Please see the Glencourse Cluster website for locations.

Landscaping/Tree Replacement

The board is working with Brickman to develop a combined Master Tree Replanting Plan and a Master Landscaping Plan. First and second phase of planting will begin in the spring. Areas include the entrance, exits, tot lot and lower Glencourse. We will also landscape around the new mailboxes and other small areas. Designs are posted on our website under the "Current Projects" tab. Please provide feedback using the form online or e-mail the board if you would like to be part of the Special Projects Committee.

Drainage

Phase I of the multi-year drainage plan was completed in November 2014. The board requested a proposal for Phase II (west side, Sections 2194-2136 Glencourse Ln), which will be scheduled tentatively this spring. Please see the cluster website.

Broken Street Lamps

The board has been actively pursuing Dominion to fix our broken street lamps. We recently hired a contractor to replace the light bulbs, but will continue to engage Dominion to fix those lights that are faulty.

Snow Removal

Residents are responsible for removing snow from private spaces. Please do NOT displace snow onto roadways or sidewalks, which may obstruct incoming traffic. Below are contract guidelines with Brickman:

- Begin snow removal once snow accumulation reaches 2" or as conditions dictate
- Curbsides in front of fire hydrants, mailboxes, or the entrances to the three dedicated fire lanes are not to be used as dumping areas for snow cleared
- Minimize snow cleared from the main roadway behind reserved parking spaces. The board will authorize the use of a loader to relocate the snow should conditions worsen



From Farm to Glencourse!

Residents are welcome to join a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program that will deliver fresh fruits/vegetables every week from a local farm to the cluster. Please see our cluster website for more information.

REMINDERS!

- Trash collection is on **Mondays** and **Thursdays**. Contact TWC if you have large items to dispose of before placing them at the curb
- Recycle collection is on **Wednesdays**
- Effective **1 Feb 2015**, cardboard will no longer be accepted during trash days. Please set cardboard out **ONLY** during recycling collection days
- Trash/recyclables are to be stored in bins and placed out no earlier than dusk the night before collection and removed no later than 9pm the day of collection
- Please keep pets on leashes at all times and remove animal waste immediately per Fairfax County ordinances and requirements
- Abide by the one-way street traffic at all times
- Visitor's parking is not for long term storage (no more than 72hrs). Please practice common courtesy and utilize visitor's parking for guests only
